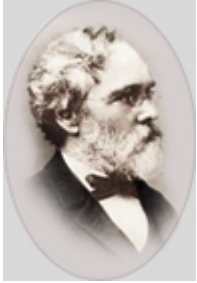
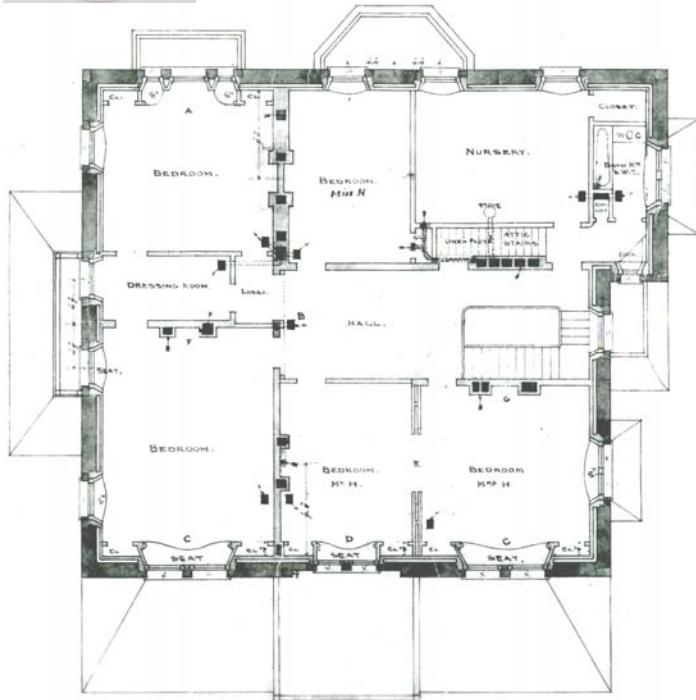


BENEFIT EVENT FOR THE

DIRECTIONS by Car

From the south: From the Vanderbilt Mansion in Hyde Park, continue north on Route 9 approximately 2.5 miles. Make a diagonal left turn onto Old Post Road. You will see the entrance to Norrie Park just ahead on the left. Follow the signs to the Hoyt House.

From the north: From the village of Rhinebeck head south on Route 9 approximately 5 miles. Turn right into Old Post Road (sign for “Staatsburgh”), drive past the entrance to Staatsburgh State Historic Site and the Staatsburgh post office, almost to the end of the road. The entrance to Norrie Park

You will be able to drive onto a dirt road leading to the house OR if you prefer you may park your car near the entrance to the dirt road and experience a picturesque walk approximately ½ mile to the house. If you drive your car onto the dirt road, you will be directed by attendants to a place to park your car on the grounds of the Hoyt House.

DIRECTIONS by Train: A Metro-North train station is in Poughkeepsie, a 20 minute taxi ride from the Hoyt House. An Amtrak train station is located at Rhinecliff, a 15 minute taxi ride.
