



PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITION MARCH 6 - APRIL 26, 2020

Calvert Vaux Preservation Alliance will hold a photography exhibition and sale from March 6 through April 26 at the Montgomery Row Art Exhibition Space, 6423 Montgomery Street, Rhinebeck, NY.

The exhibition will be curated by celebrated Hudson Valley artist, gallerist and curator FRANC PALAIA from works submitted in response to CVPA's Call for Entries and from the works of guest artists invited by Mr. Palaia. The exhibition will open on Friday, March 6 with a reception from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. The gallery is open daily from 9:00am to 6:00pm.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Images considered for the exhibition should feature historic Hudson Valley architecture and landscape design. For the purpose of this exhibition, "historic" will be defined as designed 50 years ago or before.

Works selected for exhibition may be a maximum of 28" wide and 28" long.

Each Call for Entry artist will complete the online entry form and pay an entry fee of \$25 per photograph for the first entry and \$10 per additional entry via CVPA's online payment feature.

Submissions for exhibition will be accepted electronically at info@calvertvaux.org until 5:00 pm on Thursday, February 20, 2020. Accepted entries will be notified by email on Monday, February 24, 2020.

Selected artists must make an appointment with the curator to deliver works to the Montgomery Row Gallery prior to 6:00 pm Tuesday, March 3, 2020. Works must be delivered framed, wired and ready to hang.

All art works selected for the exhibition must remain on display through the exhibition closing on April 26, 2020.

CVPA will not carry insurance on art works accepted for exhibition. Any damage or loss is the responsibility of the artist.

Artists must make an appointment with the curator to pick up exhibited works no later than 6:00 pm April 30, 2020.

Artists will be paid a commission of 50% on sales. Proceeds from the exhibition and sale remaining after the payment of artist commissions will benefit Calvert Vaux Preservation Alliance (CVPA), a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization. CVPA's mission is to restore and find sustainable uses for The Point in Staatsburg, NY and to promote the legacy of Calvert Vaux.

Submitting artists must:

- Complete and sign the *Permission to Hang Work at Montgomery Row* and the *CVPA Online Entry Form* and pay applicable entry fees.
- Abide by the *Montgomery Row Art Exhibit Guidelines* and these CVPA Submission Guidelines.
- Assign a price to each work submitted for exhibition.
- Submit an artist biography or artist statement for publication in the exhibition materials.
- Make appointments for drop off and pick up with the curator during posted times.

Artists selected for exhibition are encouraged to:

- Attend the opening reception.
- Forward invitations to friends and associates.
- Pass on media contacts.
- Distribute the exhibition card at venues you frequent.
